Affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi, HPJC has adopted the syllabus of CBSE and prepares the students for All India Senior Secondary Certificate Examination (Grade 12). The school aims to create a stimulating, secure and sustainable learning environment. Holy Public Junior College is known for fostering a warm and caring environment for all its children while ensuring that every child develops at his/her own pace and finally turns out to be a confident and independent learner.

Our Motto

Admission and withdrawal

- Admissions are open to all irrespective of caste, creed or religion.
- Admission is granted purely on merit after test and interview.
- Registration for a particular year is not transferable to any other year.
- Fees once paid is not refundable.
- A student desirous of withdrawing from the school should give one month's notice in advance or pay school fees in lieu of the notice period.
- All school dues must be cleared before a Transfer Certificate can be issued.

Documents Required at the Time of Admission

- Attested copy of Birth Certificate issued by Municipal Corporation.
- Transfer Certificate duly signed by Area Education Officer along with report card of the previous class.
- Address proof and Identification.
- 4 Photographs of the student.
- Medical history records and other details about the child that may be important.
- Aadhaar card.

Attendance

- No student should miss class or keep away from co-curricular activities conducted in the school.
- A student is required to have at least 75% of Attendance of the total working days to entitle him/her to appear in the final examination.
- Exemption in deserving cases is granted only when a parent applies for the leave of his son/daughter on medical grounds or death of a near relative.

Examination & Promotion

- The progress report will be shown only to the parents or guardians after every term examination.
- The final term examination held usually in the month of March is not to be considered as the promotion examination since it carries only 50% of the maximum marks remaining 50% marks are allotted to the half yearly examination.
- Students who are absent in an examination for any reason whatsoever will not be re-examined.
- For promotion to the next higher class, it is mandatory for the student to achieve atleast 33% marks in the following.
- Internal assessment, based on daily work such as home work, class work, projects and unit test.
 - Term examinations usually held in September and February/March.
 - SUPW
 - Physical Education
 - Art Education
 - General Knowledge
- Taking First term and Final term examination is compulsory for promotion.
- Promotion once refused will not be reconsidered.

Curriculum
